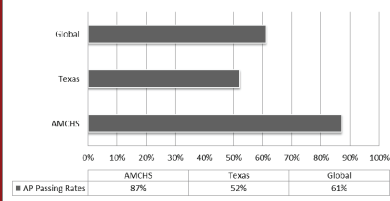

## COMMUNITY

In 1990, the state of Texas granted a charter for an independent school district to encompass the campus of Texas A&M University. By 1940, the school had grown to the point that it moved off the university campus, thus marking the birth of College Station I.S.D. Today, College Station I.S.D. is one of two public school districts in Brazos County. The district has two high schools, two middle schools, two intermediate schools, eight elementary schools, and one alternative education center. A&M Consolidated High School is a comprehensive public high school with approximately 1800 students in grades 9-12.

## CURRICULUM

A&M Consolidated provides a diverse curriculum that allows students to design unique programs to meet their individual needs and goals. Choices include regular academic classes, honors courses in all academic areas, advanced placement courses, fine arts, athletics, career and technology, as well as a variety of extra-curricular activities, clubs, and student organizations.
