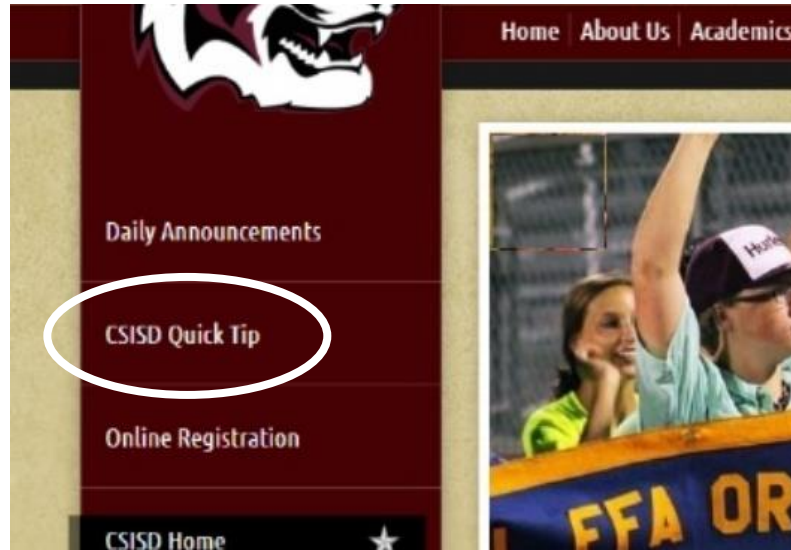


More Senior Details...

Performance Acknowledgements – if you want one of these on your transcript you must fill out the paperwork and turn it into the counseling office. Performance Acknowledgements can be earned in the following ways:

- 12 dual credit hours with a grade of at least 3.0
- Bilingualism/Bi-literacy – foreign language path (4 years in the same language, score a 3 or higher on a foreign language AP exam; bilingual/ESL path – exited ESL, scored advanced high on TELPAS, score a 3 or higher on an AP exam for language other than English.
- AP – score 3 or better on an AP exam
- PSAT/ACT/SAT – PSAT National Merit, PSAT Commended scholar, National Hispanic Scholar, SAT score of 1250 or ACT score of 28
- Business or Industry Certificate – obtain a national or international business or industry certification or obtain a government-required credential to practice a profession

TASSL - (Tiger After School Success Lab)- need to make up a couple of credits to graduate? We have night school! See your counselor if this applies to you. Your counselor must recommend you for a night school session. Fees apply.

THE COALITION



(Free Application for Federal Student Aid) YOU SHOULD APPLY!!! File as close to Oct 1 as possible! Get it done early! Request a PIN via email. Submit no later than March 1 to your colleges.

Essay – 2 minutes to hook the reader, respect word limits

Resume – need one, volunteering, extra curriculars, leadership, mentoring, brag on yourself

Scholarships – check our website, look at your college, don't pay for someone to search – you do it!

AP Exams - \$94 per exam, can pay online, final payment due end of March, check website for info

NCAA – need an account ASAP, take the SAT/ ACT, send transcript to Clearinghouse, School code 9999

ACT - Dec 8 – Deadline Nov 2
SAT – Nov 3 – Deadline Oct 5
SAT - Dec 1 – Deadline Nov 2
ASVAB – Nov 15
TSI – Nov 14 or April 18
AP – May 6-17

Important Deadlines

- Transcripts 5 days before the deadline
- Letters of rec 10 days before the deadline
